We have now 407 permanent staff in the hospital.

PG Courses for doctors:

Our hospital is recognized by the National Board to train doctors in the disciplines of Family Medicine and General Medicine for the award of D.N.B. degrees. We are also a centre for the M.Med training for doctors under the university (organized by CMC Vellore) for their contact programmes. There is also a one year Nurse Anaesthesia Assistant training programme run by the department of Anaesthesia.

The Area of Spiritual Nurture:



The sudden home call of Dr.Alex on the 5th of May was a shocking news for the CF Community. Dr.Alex and Sr.Hanna Alex have been serving like resident chaplains for the last 6 years in the CF Campus. This campus is being increasingly used for personal, family and small group retreats. EMFI medical students' camps are conducted twice a year. It is our hope and prayer that the

Community Health Department Initiatives

- 1. Village Clinics & Self-help groups' initiatives continue to function well.
- 2. Palliative Care done by Dr.Anish and team continue to benefit patients requiring end of life care.
- 3. The School health team visit schools and conduct programmes to address health issues, gives group education on issues specific to their age and teaches life skills.
- 4. Community health awareness campaigns were conducted on issues like Dengue Fever, importance of using toilets and avoiding open air defecation, against child abuse, need for blood donation etc.
- 5. CMHIS Medical camps were conducted in 12 villages.
- 6. A Silver Jubilee alumni reunion of DNB Family Medicine and Primary Care Training programme of CFH was conducted from 3rd to 5th of November 2017.
- 7. Weekly meetings for old age people are being conducted in 3 villages, 16 people were given hearing aids using government schemes, Income generating activities like making paper bags, agarbathis were done.
- 8. Evening tuition centers for school children are being conducted in 5 villages.
- 9. Career guidance and adolescent groups
- 10. Family enrichment programmes

Boys Home and Sadhuji Home:

Sadhuji home continues to take care of destitute inmates. Mr.Keba and Mrs.Kamu Keba are staying there to oversee its activities. There are 10 boys in the boy's home who are being taken care of and sent to the local school.
