

Introduction

Oddanchatram is a taluk in Dindigul District of the state of Tamilnadu, located on the main road between Dindigul and Palani, accessible by both train and road. During 1950's

Oddanchatram was surrounded by poverty stricken villages and people with severe malnutrition and anaemia. Leprosy was prevalent in many villages. Most of them lived in thatched houses and repair was beyond their reach. Unemployment added to their misery. It was during this period that, our founder, Dr. A. K. Tharien, having surrendered his life to Jesus Christ wanted to use his medical skills to uplift the poor and marginalized, as an outpouring of his faith, depending on God.




History

The Christian Fellowship Hospital is run by the Christian Fellowship, a charitable society which was established by a small group in 1955. It began as a small one room clinic in response



to certain perceived needs in a backward area. It was started with the charitable and benevolent purpose of promoting spiritual, moral, mental and social advancement of the community in and around Oddanchatram. It aims to serve as a Christ centered witness through the ministry of healing the whole person and being involved in other developmental programmes of the community.

At present the hospital has 299 beds with major specialty departments. The outpatient department has an average footfall of over 1000 patients daily.





surgeries are performed annually. The busy intensive care is equipped for emergency care including coronary care. There is also a paediatric ICU and Neonatal care unit. Great emphasis is placed on community health

programmes by organized village clinics, home visits, school health education programs and other projects for development and education.

Hospital is also certified by National Accreditation Board for hospital and Health Care providers (NABH)

Community health services involve activities of prevention of diseases, health promotion,



curative care and sound referral system. The institution has its own community health centers, one in Pachalur (rural) hill area and four in Oddanchatram (urban) which covers a population of 25000.

The institution also works in collaboration with the government in delivering health care services to the community in and around Oddanchatram.

The hospital and all its programs are self-supporting and the educational training programs are heavily

subsidized. This has been possible because of the grace of God and sacrificial service of committed staff who make a deliberate attempt to reduce cost of spending by adopting a simpler lifestyle and functioning.

For application by hand or post

Prospectus and Application form for all the Allied Health Courses will be issued by Tutor, Department of Laboratory on payment of Rs 150(127 + 23 GST)/- in cash or by demand draft in favor of "THE CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP ALLIED HEALTH TRAINING ACCOUNT" payable at Oddanchatram. Selection procedure:

- 1. Only the suitable (refer academic qualification of the individual courses) candidates will be called for the admission through the self-addressed envelope that you have submitted.
- 2. The selection is based on academic marks and/or personal interview.
- 3. The candidates categorized as "selected /wait listed / not selected" will be intimated through post / e. mail / phone. The selected candidates are required to inform their willingness to join the courses in person or through letter by paying the prescribed fees on the date mentioned.
- 4. If the prescribed fees is not paid by the mentioned date, your seat will be allotted to the next candidate in the selection/ waiting list.
- 5. Before joining the course, physical fitness examination will be conducted by the medical staff of this hospital and those found to be unfit will not be admitted for the course.
- 6. The decision of the selection committee is final.

Note: Any time during the course, if any of the candidates or their declarations submitted is found to be false, the admission stands cancelled and the candidates will be dismissed from the courses concerned regardless of what stage in the course the candidate is in. There will be no refund of fees paid.

Sponsorship for mission hospital candidates

One seat from each of the allied health courses will be reserved for Christian mission hospitals. Candidate should submit a letter from the head of the mission hospital stating that he/she will be employed in the mission hospital after completion of the course. If there are no applicants from mission hospitals, the seat will be allotted to the



general pool. The candidate should have minimum mark (above the cut off), to be considered for the mission sponsored seat.

Additionally, one seat is reserved for female candidate for Diploma in Radio Diagnosis Technology course.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE STUDENTS:

- 1. All students are required to stay in the hostels and observe the hostel rules. Violation of rules will be dealt strictly and may even amount to dismissal.
- 2. They can dine in the hostel mess.
- 3. A mess fee for one month is to be paid in advance at the time of joining. Mess fees must be remitted before 10th of every month.
- 4. Students will be assessed periodically about their academic progress and character. Those students who do not show progress in their studies or do not follow the discipline of the institution may be asked to dis-continue the course or repeat the
 - course at their expense. Fees will not be refunded in any case.
- 5. Hepatitis B vaccination is mandatory for all students.

Parents are encouraged to meet the tutors periodically and to keep track of students performance.

Anti-Ragging

Ragging is not an acceptable behavior on the campus of Christian Fellowship Hospital. It is illegal to commit or participate in ragging. Strict action will be taken with all instances of ragging even to the expulsion of the students from the institution.



1. DIPLOMA IN MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNOLOGY



This is a two-year diploma course with 6 months internship, started in 1982. Training includes theory lectures and practical training in class rooms of the laboratory in this hospital premise itself. Every year we have an intake of 8 (eight) candidates on the basis of academic qualification and physical fitness.

English classes are taken during the first few months and Tamil classes for those students who are from other languages areas. The examinations are conducted by the examiners appointed by the Laboratory Training Committee of the board of Christian Medical Association of India. Theory examination is conducted each year and practical exam at the end of second year.

Note: The failed candidates of each year examination have to seek the help of their parents or guardian to accompany them to the examination centres as they appear for their supplementary theory examination.

1.1 Eligibility for admission:

PASS (35% minimum) in Higher secondary (+2) or its equivalent examination with a maximum of only TWO attempts of examination. The nature of courses must be as.

- 1. The +2 course comprising the subjects, PHYSICS, CHEMISTRY, BIOLOGY or as BOTANY and ZOOLOGY is mandatory.
- 2. Vocational group of "LAB TECHNICIAN COURSE" only in Tamil Nadu state.

Candidate details will be verified by Laboratory Training Committee of CMAI for approval and registration.

1.2 Details of the Course:

- Duration of the course- Two years followed by 6 months Internship.
- The course usually commences in the first week of August.
- Medium of instruction English.

1.4 Examination:

Part-I: Theory examination with Paper I and Paper II at the 11th month in the first year.

Part-II: Theory examination with Paper III and Paper IV at the end of 9th month in second year.

Practical and Oral examination: After passing Part I and II theory examinations, practical examinations will be conducted by the Laboratory Training Committee of Board of Christian Medical Association of India.

Attempts: Maximum of three attempts is allowed to appear for theory/practical exams for the course. Failing in the third attempt necessitates the students to discontinue the course.





1.5 Leave Rules:

Students are not allowed to take more than twenty days leave in a year. Apart from this, ten days of sick leave may be granted, with a Medical certificate, annually. Anyone exceeding the leave limit will not be allowed to sit for the examination but may appear for the supplementary exam conducted few months later.

1.6 Internship and Service Obligation:

After the successful completion of the course, all candidates should undergo six months

of internship. During this period, stipend will be given.

After internship, if there are vacancies in lab, candidates may be allowed to work for one and half years on a contract basis. During this period, they will be paid the staff salary.

1.7 Discontinuation of Training / Internship:

Fees paid on admission will not be refunded on any account. If any candidate voluntarily discontinues the course before completion, he / she will be required to pay the fees for the whole course. Those who voluntarily discontinue the internship, will be required to pay compensation as decided by the authorities.

1.9 Interest Free – Education Loan

Interest free loan scholarship from the institution may be given to deserving candidates. This should be refunded in instalments after completion of the course, during the internship/serving period.

The prescribed text book and record note books will be provided at the actual cost.

1.11 Uniform:

Students have to buy two sets of uniform.

- For Girls: Maroon churidar top & bottom with white overcoat.
- For Boys: White shirt, black pant and white overcoat.



2. DIPLOMA IN MEDICAL RECORD TECHNOLOGY

This is a two-year diploma course designed to give training in Medical Records Department recognized by the Christian Medical Association of India New Delhi. The student is expected to have a clear understanding about the functions of medical record professionals in providing

health information in a hospital, to become proficient in maintaining medical records on par with the current standards, to develop the expertise in compiling hospital and patient care statistics and have a basic understanding of the legal aspects of medical records.

The main objective of the course is to upgrade technical skills/work efficiency in the core areas of health facility management. It covers management of inpatient and outpatient medical records and department registration services, also involving modules of coding of diseases and diagnostic indexing as per ICD 10. Additionally, the course covers legal issues related to medical records, audits by relevant agencies like NABH, accuracy in filing, retrieving and maintaining records.



This MRT course includes theory lectures and practical training both in classroom and in the medical records section of the hospital. Classes are taken in English. Examiners appointed by the Medical Records Training Committee of the Christian Medical Association of India conduct the examinations. The CMAI MRT Diploma will be conferred after the successful completion of the above examinations and required internship. Every year we have an intake of 8 students for the course

2.1 Eligibility for admission:

Pass in Higher Secondary 10+2 examination (12th Standard) or its equivalent. Students who have done other than science group in 10+2 course also are eligible to apply (any group). Knowledge of computer is desirable.

2.2 Details of the course:

- The duration of the course is 2 years followed by 6 months internship.
- Course usually commences in the first week of August.
- Medium of Instruction is English.

First Year

- 1. Medical Record Science
- 2. Para Clinicals
 - Anatomy and Physiology
 - Laboratory Science
 - Pharmacology
 - Pathology
- 3. Hospital Statistics and General Statistics
- 4. Communication Skills in English



Second Year

- 1. Medical Terminology
- 2. ICD Coding and Indexing
- 3. Computer Science and Medical Legal Cases
- 4. Hospital Organization and Administration
- 5. Project work

Students are required to do a project work in another hospital and should present the record to the Board – Controller of Examination.

2.4 Examination

Part I – Theory examination and viva at the end of 12 months – 1st year

Part II – Theory examination, practical and viva on project at the end of 2nd year

These examinations will be conducted by the Medical Record Technologist Training Committee of CMAI, New Delhi. Minimum marks to pass the board examination would be an

aggregate of 50%, both in theory and viva. But for the subject ICD coding and indexing, minimum pass mark is 60%.

2.5 Leave Rules

80% attendance is mandatory for appearing for examinations. Loss of attendance of more than 10 continuous days during the course will disqualify the student to sit for the final examination.

2.6 Internship and Service Obligation

After successful completion of the course all candidates are required to undergo 6 months of internship during which a stipend will be given.



After the internship, candidates are to serve for further period of one year if the institution requires. They will be paid staff salary during service obligation period.

2.7 Discontinuation of Training / Internship / Serving Period

Fees paid on admission will not be refunded on any account. If any candidate voluntarily discontinues the course before completion, he/she will be required to pay the fees for the whole course. Those who voluntarily discontinue the internship/serving period will be required to pay compensation as decided by the authorities.

3. DIPLOMA IN RADIODIAGNOSIS TECHNOLOGY

Diploma in Radio Diagnosis Technology is a two year Diploma Course started in 2004 which is intended to give training in taking X-ray of human body, radiographic techniques,

radio diagnosis and related modalities. Basic training in MRI and CT scanning is also provided. Course includes theory, lectures, tutorial demonstrations and practical work. Every year we have an intake of eight (8) candidates on the basis of academic qualification and medical fitness. CMAI Radio Diagnosis Technology diploma will be after the conferred successful completion of academic examination.



3.1 Eligibility for admission:

Pass in Higher secondary 10+2 examination (12th) or its equivalent with Physics and English as subjects. Candidates must complete 17 years on or before 31st December 2023.

3.2 Details of the course

- Duration of the course- 2 years.
- The course commences usually in August
- Medium of instruction will be English.

Practical Work

An average of six hours per day is required under the supervision of a qualified technologist. Record books have to be maintained by all students.

3.4 Examination

Examination of each subject consists of two parts, Part I containing questions involving short answers and definitions for



forty marks and Part II consisting of relatively long questions for sixty marks. Duration of each paper (Part I and II together) is three hours. Pass mark for each section shall be 50%.

Practical and Oral Exam

At the end of each year, practical and viva voce examination will be conducted. Each student will need to submit practical record book during the exam.

3.5 Leave Rules

Total working days including examination period in an academic year shall be 270. Minimum attendance requirement (subject wise) 85%. Any one exceeding the leave limit will not be allowed to sit for the examination but may appear for the supplementary exam conducted few months later.

3.6 Internship and Service Obligation

Candidates may be given an option for 6 month internship after completion of 2 years of study. The candidates are to serve for a further period of one year if the institution requires.

3.7 Discontinuation of Training Period/ Internship/ Service Obligation

Fee paid on admission will not be refunded on any account. If any candidate voluntarily discontinues the course before completion, he/she will be required to pay the fees of the whole course. Those who voluntarily discontinue



the internship/ serving period will be required to pay compensation as decided by the authorities.



- 8. Demand Draft/Copy of Cash Receipt/Copy of Transaction receipt for the prescribed fee. For all bank transfer/ online transactions, transaction receipt with transaction number is mandatory.
