Our Heritage

The College of Nursing grew out of a long-standing tradition of compassionate medical service in Oddanchatram, Tamil Nadu. In the 1950s, villages surrounding Oddanchatram faced widespread poverty, malnutrition, and limited access to healthcare.

During this time, Dr. A. K. Tharien and his small team, moved by Christian faith and compassion, dedicated their lives to serving the poor and marginalized through medical care, calling themselves “**The Christian Fellowship**”. What began as a small one-room clinic gradually developed into a centre of healing and hope for the region. The hospital and its

educational institutions continue this legacy of service, guided by the motto 'Serve in Love.'

Christian Fellowship Hospital

The College of Nursing functions in close association with Christian Fellowship Hospital, a charitable institution established in 1955. Today, the hospital is a 300-bed multi-speciality institution providing comprehensive healthcare services. The outpatient department serves over 1,000 patients daily, and the hospital conducts more than 700 deliveries and 3,500 surgeries annually.

Modern facilities include intensive care services, a Paediatric ICU and a Neonatal intensive care, a cardiac catheterisation lab, dialysis, endoscopy, major speciality departments, and comprehensive diagnostic and treatment services. These resources provide students with excellent clinical exposure and practical training.

Community Health and Outreach

Community health is an integral part of the institution's mission. The hospital operates six community health centres, including one in the rural hill area of Pachalur and five in and around Oddanchatram, serving a rural population of approximately 25,000 people.

Nursing students participate in community clinics, home visits, school health programmes, maternal and child health services, and health education initiatives. These activities provide valuable experience in community-based and preventive healthcare.

College of Nursing

Recognizing the growing need for trained nursing professionals, the School of Nursing was established in 1978 with the Auxiliary Nurse Midwife (ANM) programme. In 1980 it was upgraded to offer the General Nursing and Midwifery (GNM) course.

In 2019 the institution was further upgraded to College of Nursing offering the B.Sc. Nursing programme with an annual intake of 60 students. The first batch of B.Sc. Nursing students successfully completed their course in November 2023, marking an important milestone in the growth of the institution.

B.SC. NURSING COURSE

The B.Sc. Nursing programme is a four-year undergraduate course committed to preparing professionally competent and spiritually grounded nursing graduates. The curriculum integrates sound scientific knowledge with extensive clinical training, enabling students to develop critical thinking, clinical skill, and compassionate care.

Students receive comprehensive clinical exposure in major specialties including Medical, Surgical, Obstetrics and Gynaecology, Paediatrics, and Operation Theatre, along with other specialized areas of practice. This structured training ensures holistic professional formation and readiness for diverse healthcare settings.

The College provides a conducive learning environment with spacious classrooms, well-equipped laboratories, and a well-stocked library featuring updated textbooks, journals, and national and international publications. Guided by experienced faculty members who are dedicated to academic excellence and Christian values, the institution seeks to shape nurses who serve with competence, integrity, and the spirit of Christ-like compassion.

AFFILIATION / RECOGNITION

The College is **affiliated to The Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai** and recognised by:

- Government of Tamil Nadu
- Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council, Chennai
- Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi

The four-year B.Sc. Nursing programme is designed to prepare students for professional nursing practice through a balanced combination of theoretical instruction, clinical training, and community health experience. The syllabus consists of 8 semesters, and university examinations are conducted at the end of each semester.

Attendance:

This is a professional course, and the University requires a minimum of 80% attendance in theory classes and 100% attendance in practical/clinical classes **in every subject** before being allowed to sit for the examination.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

1. **Age:** The **minimum age for admission is 17 years** on or before **31st December** of the year in which admission is sought.
2. **Educational qualification:** Candidates should have passed the **qualifying examination after 12 years of study** (10+2 / PUC examination from a recognized board) with an individual pass in Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany & Zoology) and English, **securing a minimum of 45% aggregate marks in the above subjects.**
3. **English must be a compulsory subject** in both **10th and +2** examinations.

4. **5% relaxation of the total marks** will be given for **SC/ST candidates**, as per Government norms.
5. At present, the programme admits **only unmarried female candidates** here.
6. Candidates from **State Open School recognized by the State Government** and **National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS)** with science subjects and English are also eligible.
7. The following candidates must produce **Eligibility Certificate from The Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai** at the time of registration after admission:
 - Candidates who have passed qualifying examinations other than the **Higher Secondary Examination conducted by the Government of Tamil Nadu**
 - Candidates who have passed **+2 examinations from other States**
 - **Non-Resident Indians (NRI) / Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) / Persons of Indian Origin (PIO)**
 - **Foreign Nationals**
8. The candidate **must be medically fit**.

SELECTION PROCESS

Out of **60 seats, 30 seats are allotted to the Management** for selection under the process mentioned below.

Out of these, **24 seats are reserved for Christian candidates.**

The remaining 30 seats will be filled through Government of Tamil Nadu counselling by the Directorate of Medical Education

SELECTION FOR THE MANAGEMENT

Among the applicants, the top 180 candidates, based on their Plus Two (12th) marks and the seat matrix norms, will be called for an interview and a **written test** for final selection. The candidate should have a minimum aggregate of 55% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology.

The written test includes:

- English
- Simple Mathematics
- General Knowledge
- General Ability

(All questions will be **multiple choice**.)

These short listed candidates called for the **personal interview** will be assessed for:

- Knowledge
- Communication skills
- Aptitude and interest in nursing

Final selection will be based on the **overall performance in the written test and interview**.

Candidates **willing to serve the institution for a minimum of one year after completion of the programme** will be preferred.

SEAT MATRIX AND SPONSORSHIP

- **Three seats** are allotted for **Mission Hospital-sponsored candidates**
- **One seat** is reserved for an **Inter Ashram Fellowship-sponsored candidate**
- **Two seats** are reserved for **children of Christian Fellowship Hospital staff** who have completed 10 years of service

Eligible candidates desiring to be sponsored can apply for sponsorship **only in one of the above categories**. They need to apply to the organisations concerned and should submit the letter of sponsorship from them along with the application form.

Sponsored candidates are required to serve a minimum period of one year in the sponsoring hospital after they finish their course.

FINAL SELECTION

Selection is strictly based on the above tests and norms. No recommendation whatsoever will be considered.

The decision of the Selection Committee shall be final.

If at any time during the course **any certificate or declaration submitted is found to be false**, the admission will be **cancelled and the candidate dismissed**, irrespective of the stage of the course.

EDUCATIONAL LOAN SCHOLARSHIP

A **limited number of interest-free educational loan scholarships** (up to **Rs. 50,000 per year**) are available for **needy students**.

Students availing this facility are required to **work in Christian Fellowship Hospital for two years after completion of the course** and repay the loan amount.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

All selected candidates will undergo a physical fitness examination conducted by the medical staff of Christian Fellowship Hospital.

Candidates found **medically unfit will not be admitted** to the course.

VACCINATION

Vaccination against Hepatitis B is mandatory.

Payment for the vaccination must be made **at the time of admission if selected.**

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Application forms for the B.Sc. Nursing course can be obtained from the College of Nursing Office on payment of **Rs. 1000**.

If the application form is to be sent by post, an additional **Rs. 50** will be charged.

Payment may be made **in cash** or by **Demand Draft drawn in favour of: “College of Nursing, Christian Fellowship Hospital” Payable at Oddanchatram.**

AFTER JOINING THE COURSE:

ASSESSMENT

Assessment will be conducted **as per University guidelines**, including:

- Theory examinations
- Practical examinations
- Oral examinations

Both **internal and external assessments** will be carried out.

EXAMINATION

As per **University regulations**, prescribed examination fees (subject to change) must be **paid before the examination**.

University examinations are conducted **at the end of every semester (once every six months)**.

REGISTRATION / ENROLMENT

Students admitted to the B.Sc. Nursing Programme must register with:

The Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Chennai

Registration forms, along with the prescribed fee, must be **submitted through the Head of the Institution within the stipulated time**.

PAYMENT OF FEES

Students are required to **pay the prescribed fees by the stipulated dates, in accordance with** institutional rules.

Fees **once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.**

In case of **discontinuation**, candidates will be required to **pay the fees for the entire course duration of four years**, as vacant seats cannot be filled after the university cut-off date.

Only students who have **paid the prescribed fees** will be permitted to **appear for examinations.**

ACCOMMODATION

All students are **required to stay in the hostel.**

They are expected to abide by the hostel rules and regulations and remain accountable to the hostel warden.

HOSTEL FACILITIES

The hostel block, located within the campus, provides a safe and comfortable home away from home for female students.

Facilities include:

- Well-maintained living rooms
- Recreation facilities
- Adequate sanitary facilities
- Good water supply

DISCIPLINE

Students are expected to observe the rules and regulations of the College and Hostel. Violation of these rules will result in **strict disciplinary action**, including **dismissal from the course**.

DRESS CODE

Student nurses must **wear the prescribed uniform during all class and clinical hours**.

At other times, both **inside and outside the hostel premises**, students are expected to **dress modestly**.
